PASTOR'S REFLECTIONS by Rev. Arch Wallace

The three aims of TBC in seeking to live its Mission of being a place where Christ's disciples can worship, study and serve include (1) Developing Disciples of Christ, (2) Extending Radical Hospitality and (3) Growing Young Together. 


JAM
