
The mission/goal of the Friends of Barnabas is to "heal, educate, and empower" through ongoing programs that are focused on improving the lives of children and their families. Health education and training are provided during clinic visits to each village and throughout the year as staff make home visits, offer classes for parents, community leaders, and health professionals. These efforts empower individuals and communities to take ownership of their health and well being and become more self-sufficient.

This week, Cathy Kirkland and Charles Hunt join 11 other team members to provide medical, dental, and vision care to five communities committed to improving their health. Also included will be clinics for vital signs, deworming, vitamins, and early-childhood development measurement. *Follow their trip on "Friends of Barnabas Blog."*

Many of you have been an integral part of this endeavor. They want to express sincere appreciation to all who have embraced this mission trip by donating diapers/pins,

sunglasses, toothbrushes, pocket prayer shawls, and funds for medicines, doctors, translators, and medical supplies.




JAM


