
PASTOR'S REFLECTIONS by Rev. Arch Wallace

Last week we were challenged to consider a new and radical way of doing justice, doing it the way God does it. We learned that God's justice is not our justice, that God's justice calls us to action, to practice radical generosity, to accept the universal equality of all and to engage in life changing advocacy. This approach to justice pushes our understanding of what God expects of us way beyond the concepts of fundamental fairness and due process that we normally associate with justice. We will return to Micah 6:6-8 in late June to be sure we do not miss what God has to say about mercy.

This Sunday we will turn to the church's annual calendar and celebrate the final step in Christ's earthly mission to rescue us, as we consider the significance of Ascension Sunday. The is the day the risen Christ returned to His heavenly Father, completing his earthly mission. The Day assures us that we have an advocate standing by and waiting for us when it is time for our return home.





The last Tiny Disciple Hour will be May 19. We will resume Discipleship Hour on September 8.


JAM
